The Act

For the French market, the "triman" pictogram with sorting information is mandatory on all products covered by a sorting instruction since 01 January 2022.

The French AGEC law (anti-waste circular economy law) defines the use of "triman" sign and "sorting instructions" in its [application decree no. 2021-385 of 29 June 2021](#).

Definition of *producer*: The term *producer* refers to the first producer to market a product in France, i.e. the person who manufactures, imports or distributes a product under his own brand, for the first time on the national market. Resellers are not concerned.

Solutions offered by Créabox and its partners

1/ cardboard packaging (case, ear box, shoe box, etc.): integrate signage into the graphic file; for neutral packaging, provide 1 printing color or apply an adhesive label.

2/fabric packaging (pouch, dust bag, tote bag, cover, etc.):
- either print these pictograms directly on the pouch or bag
- or sew a printed label inside the pouch or bag.
